### **The Leprosy Mission Trust India**

<b>Implementing agency</b>	The Leprosy Mission Trust India (TLMTI),
<b>Introduction of the agency</b>	The Leprosy Mission Trust India (TLMTI), registered under Societies Registration Act of 1860 in the year 1973, with its corporate office at New Delhi.
<b>CSR activity</b>	Providing better health facilities to leprosy affected and other poor people by constructing and equipping operation theatre and maternity block in The Leprosy Mission hospitals in Champa, Chhattisgarh, Faizabad, Uttar Pradesh and Vadathorasalur, Tamil Nadu.
<b>Objective of the project</b>	To construct an operation theatre for better treatment of needy people. Equip the operation theatre with latest medical equipments. Construct and equip maternity block and Intensive Care Unit (ICU) for better treatment of needy people.
<b>Project cost</b>	Rs. 4.99 crore
<b>Project duration:</b>	12 months
<b>Project location</b>	For providing better health facilities, the names of the centres is as under: TLM Community hospital, Faizabad, Uttar Pradesh TLM hospital, Vadathorasalur, Vellupuram district, Tamil Nadu TLM hospital, Champa, Jajgir district, Chhattisgarh.
<b>Target beneficiaries</b>	The people affected by Leprosy as well as people suffering from other diseases. General patients having poor paying capacities. Approx. 2 lakh people receive services from TLM centres every year.
<b>Allocation to CSR project head:</b>	The project falls under the category "Eradicating hunger, poverty and malnutrition, promoting preventive health care and sanitation, including contribution to the Swachh Bharat Kosh set-up by the Central Government for the promotion of sanitation and making available safe drinking water".
